



Preferred Room Configuration

If possible, the following room setup seems to work best for my presentations. However, if there are reasons the room must be setup differently, that's fine and I can work with it.

1. Room setup is best when people sit across its width. If the room is set up long like a bowling alley, I find there to be less participation. If it is set up wide, everyone is closer to the front and usually are more willing to interact. Please see example 1 for the "not desired" setup.

2. Table seating is preferred - if possible, round tables that are only 80% full work best. This way no one has to have their back to the presentation. Please see examples 2 & 3 for desired setup.
